



TERRA COTTA WARRIORS AT THE NATIONAL GEOGRAPHIC MUSEUM

March 24, 2010

This delightful day in DC begins on the National Mall, where you will enjoy free time to explore the mighty museums of the Smithsonian. In the afternoon, enjoy admission to the National Geographic Museum to meet the world-famous Terra Cotta Warriors, life-sized figures buried with the first Emperor of China more than 2,000 years ago. Don't miss this amazing exhibition on the last stop of its American tour!

Arrive at the National Mall in Washington, DC around 10:00 AM to enjoy free time at the mighty museums of the Smithsonian and the National Gallery of Art. At 2:30 PM, head nearby to the museum at the headquarters of the



National Geographic Society for a special exhibition called "Terra Cotta Warriors: Guardians of China's First Emperor." Celebrate the chance discovery by Chinese farmers digging a well of life-sized terra cotta figures, which were sculpted with great skill and buried in a vast underground chamber more than 2,000 years ago. This amazing exhibition, which is making the last stop on a three-city tour of America, lets you come face-to-face with fifteen of these world-famous figures, including soldiers of various ranks, archers, a stable boy, a charioteer, a civil official, a strongman, and a pair of musicians, all created to accompany the first Emperor of China on his journey to the hereafter. You will enjoy two hours to wonder at the figures, delight in other treasures from the tomb, and explore other fascinating exhibits in the museum. Come home with a treasure



trove of memories after a delightful day in DC, with expected arrival in Hunt Valley at 7:20 PM, Shrewsbury 7:40 PM, York 8:00 PM, and Red Lion 8:30 PM.
