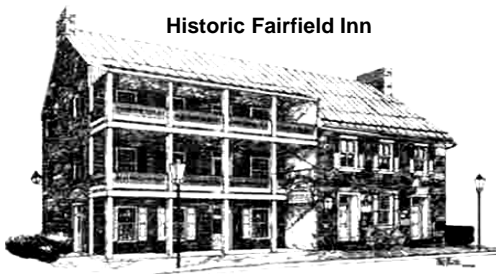

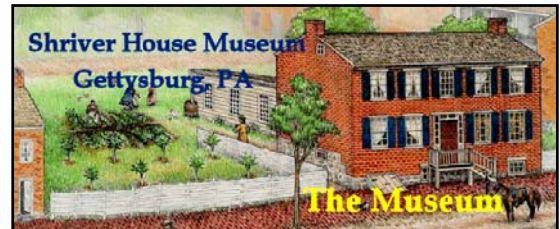
Head to Gettysburg to begin our historic fun at the Battle Theater. Here you will enjoy "Fast Men and Feisty Women," a presentation describing the lives of colorful characters who lived in Gettysburg during Civil War times.



Historic Fairfield Inn

Motor next to Fairfield for lunch at one of America's oldest continuously operating inns, the Fairfield Inn. Squire Miller, founder of Fairfield, built the inn back in 1757, and visitors have included historical figures from Patrick Henry (the Squire's nephew) to Robert E. Lee (who halted here for food after his loss at Gettysburg) to President and Mamie Eisenhower (who enjoyed dinners here). Tour the historic inn before enjoying lunch here, and look forward to being joined after lunch by none other than Mrs. Ulysses S. Grant, who will set us straight on the dress and manners of the 19<sup>th</sup> century. (Her

husband not being known as a sharp dresser, she will leave him home.) After departing the inn, return to Gettysburg to tour the Shriver House Museum, which is dedicated to portraying the civilian experience during the Battle of Gettysburg. You can tour all four floors of the historic house, which looks much the way it did in 1860, from the saloon in the basement to the garret, which was used as a sharpshooter's nest by Confederate soldiers. A nifty museum shop offers many interesting items. Return from Gettysburg after a truly intriguing day, with expected arrival in York at 6:00 PM, Red Lion 6:30 PM.
