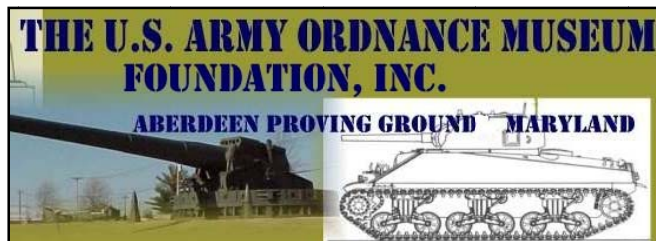

## A WINDOW ON WORLD WAR ONE

April 28, 2010

Get a unique look at the art and weapons of World War One, with a delightful lunch at the Silver Spring Mining Company along the way. See vintage original posters from WW I by artists like Norman Rockwell at special exhibits in Maryland, and view armaments from that war and many others at the amazing US Army Ordnance Museum in Aberdeen. It's a fascinating day in pretty Harford County!

Head to Maryland's Harford County to see the "Winds and Words of War" traveling exhibition of forty framed, vintage posters designed to mobilize public support for World War One. Renowned illustrators like Charles Dana Gibson and the young Norman Rockwell created these patriotic lithographs, which provide unique insight into American history and culture. The Harford County Public Library is hosting the exhibition in this region, and we stop first at the Jarrettsville Branch Library to see some of the famous posters, and view the rest of the collection at the Bel Air Branch Library. Staying in Bel Air for a delightful lunch, enjoy the Miner's Joe Lunch with salad and apple pie at the popular Silver Spring Mining Company. After lunch, head to the Aberdeen Proving Ground, the Army's oldest active proving ground for all types of military equipment, including tanks and artillery. Here the capabilities of both American and foreign armaments have been tested since the World War One era, when equipment was brought here from Europe. Displayed outside at the US Army Ordnance Museum, you will find innumerable tanks and other large weapons from many armies and eras.



Inside the museum, examine armament and explosives from militaries around the world, with exhibits about their development. Since much of the museum's collection is in the process of being relocated to a Virginia facility over the next few years, this may be your last chance to see many of the artifacts closer to home. Return from the museum after a fascinating day in a pretty part of Maryland, with expected arrival in Red Lion at 7:30 PM and York 8:00 PM.
