## FRANK LLOYD WRIGHT'S DUNCAN HOUSE

May 1, 2010

Experience the organic architectural vision of Frank Lloyd Wright and his master apprentice Peter Berndtson in a tranquil setting at the Polymath Park Resort in the beautiful Laurel Highlands. Including lunch nearby at popular Brady's Restaurant, this is a delightful May Day adventure.

Travel west to the scenic Laurel Highlands in western Pennsylvania to share in the spirit of master architect Frank Lloyd Wright. Arriving in the little village of Acme, stop first for the lunch buffet at Brady's, a longtime local favorite with a rustic log cabin atmosphere. Then motor nearby to the Polymath Park Resort, which was planned to embody the organic vision of master architect Frank Lloyd Wright.



Here Wright's apprentice Peter Berndtson built two homes in Wright's Usonian Style, and Wright's own 1957 Donald C. Duncan House was relocated here from Illinois. Our guide will lead us to Wright's Duncan House, the Balter House (Berndtson's stone and redwood vacation home), and the Blum House (Berndtson's stone and glass marvel).

Also explore the peaceful property in its spectacular Laurel Highlands setting. Enjoy the scenic trip home after this intriguing May Day adventure, with expected arrival in New Cumberland at 7:50 PM, York 8:30 PM, Red Lion 9:00 PM.
