The famous Action Track is a favorite of many NASCAR drivers, who come to Richmond ready to battle side-by-side on this premier short track. Expect intense competition in this year's Crown Royal 400, and be ready to cheer your favorite driver on to victory from your reserved seat. NOTE: This is a family-oriented tour; rowdiness will not be tolerated. Alcoholic beverages and smoking are not permitted on the bus. These rules are strictly enforced. In the event of postponement or cancellation of the race, ticket refunds are made only if available to Red Lion Tours. No bus refunds will be made after departure. In the event of rain, the bus will remain at the race until it is completed or cancelled by NASCAR officials.

PACKAGE INCLUDES: Deluxe Motorcoach transportation, admission and reserved seating in Dogwood Section M, Rows 20, 21, 22 at Richmond International Raceway for the Crown Royal 400, and escort. A rest stop is made en route to the track; there is no rest stop during the return.

DEPOSIT/FINAL PAYMENT/CANCELLATIONS: A deposit of **\$120** is due within **10 days** of booking. Seat assignments are made based upon when we receive payment for your booked tour. Balance due **April 1, 2010**. Cancellation date is **April 1, 2010**. Full refund will be given if cancelled by this date except for some tours such as Broadway Shows and Nascar, etc. These involve non-refundable payments. There is a fee of **\$40** per person for cancellations received after this date. Plus any money for tour features or services paid to suppliers for your reservation, that is not refunded to Red Lion, can not be refunded to you. This includes any expenses we incur as a result of the cancellation. **NO REFUND** for cancellations received within **48 hours** of tour departure. All cancellation calls must be received during regular office hours, no voice mail messages. **NO REFUNDS** for failure to show up on day of tour. **SORRY – NO EXCEPTIONS!** Any refunds will be paid after tour has completed and refunds have been received from suppliers by Red Lion.

CANCELLATION/INTERRUPTION INSURANCE: We recommend you purchase insurance so if you have to cancel your reservation due to illness or a death in the family, you will be able to file an insurance claim to get your money refunded. If purchased within 7 days of your initial payment, pre-existing medical conditions will be waived. The cost is **\$19** per person. Richmond Raceway Grandstand Policies include these rules: Each fan can enter the raceway with a soft-side bag/cooler no larger than 6" x 6" x 12" and a clear plastic bag no larger than 18" x 18" x 4". Binoculars, scanners, headsets, and cameras, not placed in a bag, but worn separately over the neck or on the belt and seat cushions carried separately are also allowed. The approved bags and coolers may contain food and beverages, but no glass bottles. Ice may be in the cooler, not the plastic bag. No hard-sided coolers, insulated cups, umbrellas, or strollers.
