**DAY 2:** Enjoy the breakfast buffet before embarking on a lively tour of the capital city aboard an amphibious Duck. **DAY 3:** Enjoy breakfast before visiting the New York State Museum, where you will see a replicated Iroquois Longhouse, Adirondack dioramas, and the skeleton of the Cohoes Mastodon, a 9,000 pound beast that roamed this area.
