



NIAGARA FALLS, NEW YORK

May 16-18, 2010

Enjoy fun and thrills at Niagara Falls, a world wonder. This All-American tour requires neither passport nor birth certificate, but boasts countless attractions. Cruise beneath the Falls on the *Maid of the Mist*. Venture close to Bridal Veil Falls at the Cave of the Winds. Enjoy a dinner cruise with entertainment on the Niagara River. Gamble at Seneca Casino, take in the view from observation decks, see modern masters at the Castellani Art Museum, and dine at Top of the Falls Restaurant. It's an unforgettable adventure!

DAY 1: Travel north to Niagara Falls, New York, for fun and thrills at a great natural wonder—with no need for passport or birth certificate! Head first to the Niagara Power Vista in Lewiston, where you will have fun with



interactive displays that show how the power of the Niagara River is turned into electricity. (Hop on a bicycle to generate a little electricity yourself!) Check out the Thomas Hart Benton mural, and venture onto the observation deck, which is perched 350 feet above the Niagara River Gorge. Nearby on the campus of Niagara University, visit the Castellani Art Museum to see a distinguished collection of modern artists, including Picasso, Dali, and Miro. Then it's time to check into our home for the next two



nights, the Quality Hotel & Suites "At the Falls" (716-282-1212), which is located not far from the American Falls and a block from the Seneca Niagara Casino. Enjoy dinner this evening at the delightful Top of the Falls Restaurant overlooking the Horseshoe Falls. Return to the hotel after dinner, and enjoy free time this evening. The Falls are illuminated from 8:00 PM till midnight. There may be a fireworks display at 10:00 PM over the Falls; the 2010 schedule has not been released yet. (dinner)

DAY 2: Enjoy the buffet breakfast at the hotel before heading out with our guide on an All American Adventure Tour that will last until about 4:30 PM. See the Falls from the nation's oldest state park, visiting Goat Island and tiny Luna Island for spectacular views of the American and Bridal Veil Falls. Admission is included to the Cave of the Winds, where you can venture over wooden walkways to the Hurricane Deck to come within 20 feet of the Bridal Veils Falls (souvenir sandals and raincoat are provided!) On the west side of Goat Island, visit Terrapin Point and the

Three Sisters Islands for spectacular views of the Horseshoe Falls. Downriver, visit Whirlpool State Park. The New York State Observation Tower will provide another spectacular view of the Falls, and the "Niagara-Legends of Adventure" movie will depict the story of the Falls and the daredevils who tried to go over them. For a real thrill, you will also board the world-famous *Maid of the Mist* to cruise below the Falls. This evening enjoy a special treat as you cruise on the Niagara River aboard the *Grand Lady*, enjoying a three-course dinner and live entertainment. (breakfast, dinner)

DAY 3: Enjoy the buffet breakfast before checking out of the hotel, then try your luck for two hours at the Seneca Niagara Casino nearby. Depart from Niagara Falls at 11:00 AM, taking home bright memories of unforgettable fun at a world wonder. Expected arrival in New Cumberland is 6:50 PM, York 7:30 PM, Red Lion 8:00 PM.
