PHILADELPHIA – TERMINI BROTHERS & TROLLEY TOUR

May 19, 2010

This terrific day in the City of Brotherly Love includes a tour of the famous Termini Brothers Bakery (where you'll see baking demos and enjoy cannoli), the Reading Terminal Market (where colorful stalls burst with foods and crafts), and a delightful trolley tour that highlights the city's historic sights. Fun in Philly never fails!

Arriving in Philadelphia around 10:45 AM, begin with a tour of Termini Brothers Bakery, the traditional Italian bakery where lines often form out the door. Be whisked to the head of the line for a 40-minute tour with baking demonstrations. (One whiff will convince you of the value of Old World baking recipes requiring handmade creativity.)



After the tour, enjoy cannoli and coffee at the bakery before continuing on to the Reading Terminal Market, the historic farmers market in Center City. Here colorful stalls burst with fresh foods and unique crafts. We will be in the market over lunchtime, and you may want to order many



tempting treats—just remember we all have to fit back on the motorcoach! This afternoon, delight in a guided 90-minute trolley tour that begins on Arch Street at the Market and travels through one of America's most historic areas. Relive revolutionary events and see famous sights like Independence Hall (where the Declaration of Independence was signed and the Constitution shaped), Christ Church (where George Washington, Betsy Ross, and Ben Franklin had pews), and the Philadelphia Museum of Art (with imposing steps made famous by the movie "Rocky"). After a delightful day of colorful sights, depart reluctantly from the city where America was born. Expected arrival in Lancaster is 5:15 PM, York 6:00 PM, Red Lion 6:30 PM.
