

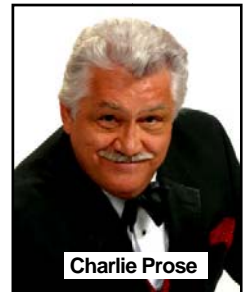


DANIEL O'DONNELL & CHARLIE PROSE

May 23-25, 2010

Delight in famed Irish singer Daniel O'Donnell and beloved performer Charlie Prose in separate performances in the beautiful Adirondacks. Stay in Lake George, cruise on the "Queen of Lakes," tour Fort William Henry, and travel Prospect Mountain Highway for spectacular views. It's a joyful jaunt, with entertainers to celebrate!

DAY 1: Traveling north to the beautiful Adirondacks, meet our guide in Queensbury, where we will have time to enjoy a little shopping in the Silo, a country store overflowing with Adirondack gifts, candles, toys, and goodies, including their famous fudge. Continuing to the southern shore of Lake George, the "Queen of Lakes," check into the Econolodge (518-668-3113) in the heart of Lake George village. This evening, dine at Sweet Basil, a local favorite in Queensbury, before having a hearty good time at Glens Falls High School, where you will enjoy the performance of Charlie Prose, beloved comedian, singer, musician, and one-man entertainment institution. DAY 2: Begin this day with a delightful breakfast cruise on Lake George aboard the *Lac du Sainte Sacrement*, the largest cruise ship on Lake George. You will enjoy spectacular views of the southern shore of the lake, which is lined by historic mansions and framed by scenic mountains. Back on shore, head down to Saratoga Springs to enjoy a brief tour before having lunch at the Golden Corral. Then it's time to visit the Saratoga Performing Arts Center for a concert by beloved Irish crooner Daniel O'Donnell. After recording his first big hit, "My Donegal Shore," O'Donnell skyrocketed to international fame with a special mix of Irish songs, easy listening melodies, and country music. This is your chance to enjoy the voice that has delighted audiences from Carnegie Hall to Sydney's Opera House. After the show, dine nearby at Longfellows, savoring fine food in a casually elegant atmosphere. (breakfast, lunch, dinner)

DAY 3: After the breakfast buffet at the hotel, embark on the Prospect Mountain Scenic Highway, heading to an overlook to enjoy a spectacular "Hundred Mile View." Back in Lake George, enter the 1755 Fort William Henry for a tour led by a costumed museum guide. Live cannon firings and Native American crafts demonstrations are presented in this historic setting, where the French and Indian War is still being fought. Then wave goodbye to sparkling Lake George and head for home, with memories of natural beauty and of happy times with Daniel O'Donnell and Charlie Prose. Expected arrival in Lancaster at 7:15 PM, York 8:00 PM, Red Lion 8:30 PM.
