



## HOUSES OF HARRISBURG

May 25, 2010

Head for highlights of Harrisburg! Begin with a whimsical stop at the Doll House Museum, where thousands of dolls and toys fill ten rooms. After lunch at the popular Firehouse Restaurant, mosey over to the Governor's Residence, where guides will greet us. Conclude with a guided tour of the impressive State Capitol Building. They're spending your money here, so you might as well enjoy a delightful day in the capital!

Arriving in Harrisburg around 10:00 AM, stop first at the Doll House Museum, where ten rooms of a life-sized Victorian Doll House are filled with 5,000 dolls and toys created from 1840 to the present. From dress-up dolls in the dining room to GI Joes in their own Headquarters Tent, you'll be immersed in decades of whimsy. Head next to a historic old fire house now renovated as the popular Firehouse Restaurant for a satisfying lunch and dessert. Then visit the Governor's Residence on Front Street near the river, where docents will lead a half-hour guided tour and you will have a little free time to explore the grounds. Upon entering at the security checkpoint, you will pass through a metal detector. To avoid problems, leave camera, backpack, large bags, cell phones, items like penknives, scissors, etc. on the motorcoach. Any items found may be confiscated. After exploring the Governor's Residence, head to the distinctive State Capitol Building, where our guided tour will be led by a docent. Here you will also pass through a security check point including metal detector upon entering, and all bags and packages will be x-rayed and may be hand searched. Occasionally, screening requires whole body pat-down. Confiscated items will not be returned. See magnificent features of the Capitol, including the amazing interior of the soaring dome and, unless in session, the ornate legislative chambers. Return home after a delightful day in our capital, with expected arrival in New Cumberland at 4:50 PM, York 5:30 PM, Red Lion 6:00 PM.
