

## LIBERTY HALL MUSEUM & GARDENS

June 5, 2010

Enjoy Afternoon Tea at Liberty Hall, the historic mansion built by a Revolutionary War leader that was home to generations of prominent New Jersey figures. Tour the impressive mansion with its historic collection and marvelous gardens, and enjoy a wide variety of elegant snacks. It's a delightful day!

Travel to Union in northeast New Jersey to arrive around 11:00 AM at Liberty Hall, a historic mansion first built in 1772 by William Livingston, signer of the Constitution and first Governor of New Jersey. For seven generations the prominent Livingston and Kean families (together with one English lord) preserved and expanded this historic



house and its beautiful gardens. Begun as a 14-room Georgian Style home, the mansion was transformed over the years into a 50-room Victorian landmark, and the gardens have grown into a horticulturalist's heaven, including an English boxwood maze, varieties of roses (including the bright yellow "Livingston Rose"), a plethora of peonies, and impressive trees. Now under the stewardship of adjacent Kean University, the mansion welcomes the public to its treasure trove of antique furniture, ceramics, textiles, clocks, silver, toys, and tools owned by seven

generations of family members, including Governors, Senators and Congressmen, pioneering women, and big businessmen. We will enjoy the Afternoon Tea Program on this historic estate, watching a brief introductory film, sampling an extensive selection of delectable delicacies, touring Liberty Hall, and strolling through the beautiful grounds and gardens. You can also visit the gift shop on the estate to check out the collection of tea pots, china, books, toys, firehouse items, brass giftware, and fine linens. After a day of elegant fun, depart at 4:00 PM, with expected arrival in Lancaster at 7:45 PM, York 8:30 PM, Red Lion 9:00 PM.
