Traveling to Maryland's beautiful Eastern Shore, explore charming Easton in Talbot County and visit homes and gardens at the Historical Society. Cruise down the pretty Tred Avon River to historic Oxford, visit the Oxford Museum, stroll and shop in this quaint old port, and enjoy great river views when you have lunch at the Masthead Restaurant. Crossing the Chesapeake Bay Bridge to reach Maryland's beautiful Eastern Shore, travel to Talbot County to discover quaint towns that cherish a long history. Stroll and shop in this delightful little port before returning home after a splendid day on the beautiful Eastern Shore, with expected arrival in Hunt Valley at 7:20 PM, Shrewsbury 7:40 PM, York 8:00 PM, Red Lion 8:30 PM.
