PROUD MARY CRUISE & EAST BROAD TOP RAILROAD

This popular tour transports you to fun by motorcoach, paddlewheel boat, narrow-gauge train, and antique trolley! Enjoy a luncheon cruise aboard the *Proud Mary* on beautiful Lake Raystown, ride the classic East Broad Top Railroad through a picturesque landscape, and board an antique trolley at the Rockhill Trolley Museum. Join our delightful excursion to make this summer Sunday a fun day!

Arriving at lovely Lake Raystown east of Altoona, board the *Proud Mary*, a Mississippi-style paddlewheeler, for a two-hour buffet luncheon cruise. Relax on the covered lower deck, or strut on the open-air promenade deck. After the cruise, motor through Trough Creek State Park, learning about Raven Trail and wondering at ice in summer at the Ice Mine.

Continuing to East Broad Top Railroad, discover a National Historic Landmark where vintage rail cars and locomotives are preserved and the Age of the Steam Train lives on. Whistles blow and the engine puffs as we travel



along the narrow track of an old coal line through the picturesque Aughwick Valley. Celebrate more than 150 years of local railroading on this delightful excursion, which is sure to make railway enthusiasts of us all! Another transportation treat awaits at Rockhill Trolley Museum, where you will ride on an antique trolley before visiting the gift shop and touring the barns where the trolley cars are restored. (The museum's collection includes the last surviving operable streetcar from York, returned to glory by intensive restoration.)
