

HARRISBURG HISTORICAL MUSEUMS

For a great tour to the state capital, we head first to the huge National Civil War Museum on a hilltop in Reservoir Park, head downtown for lunch at Raspberries in the Hilton, then explore the Pennsylvania National Fire Museum in a classic Victorian firehouse. It's a delightful day!

This fascinating day in the state capital begins at the National Civil War Museum, which occupies a beautiful hilltop building in Harrisburg's Reservoir Park. The museum has assembled a gigantic collection of Civil War artifacts. High-resolution video, sound and light shows, and life-size dioramas immerse visitors in the whole story of the Civil War, from both Union and Confederate perspectives. Learn the causes of the conflict, experience battles like Bull Run, Shiloh, Vicksburg, Chancellorsville, Antietam, and Gettysburg, and explore the aftermath of the Union victory. Be sure to take in the "Moment of Mercy" statue outside the museum, and enjoy sweeping views of the city and the Susquehanna Valley. For lunch, we head to Raspberries in the Hilton downtown to enjoy an elaborate buffet, including soup, hot and cold foods, and a dessert bar. In the afternoon, the sights, sounds and history of firefighting come to life during a guided tour of the Pennsylvania National Fire Museum. Housed in an 1899 Victorian firehouse, the museum features an outstanding collection of artifacts from yesterday's hand-drawn equipment to modern firefighting tools. Come home safe and sound after an intriguing day waging war and fighting fires! Expected arrival back in New Cumberland is 4:20 PM, York 5:00 PM, Red Lion 5:30 PM. (lunch)

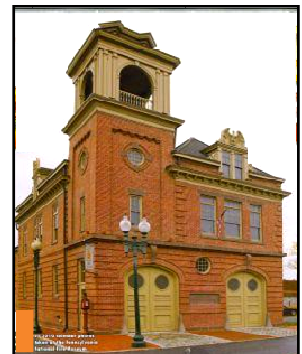
