BEST OF BOSTON

July 11-14, 2010

For historic fun, join this great tour to Boston, Cambridge, Lexington, and Concord. Among many highlights, see Boston Common and Public Garden, the Old North Church, the *USS Constitution*, the "Cheers" bar, and Harvard Yard. Enjoy time at Faneuil Hall Marketplace, the Prudential Center, and the JFK Library Museum. See where Paul Revere was captured, and visit North Bridge, where the "shot heard round the world" was fired. It's a lively look at a vibrant part of America!

DAY 1: Travel north through New England to reach Woburn on the north side of Boston, where we check into the Holiday Inn Select (781-935-8760), our convenient base for exploring Boston and Cambridge, as well as historic sites in Lexington and Concord. Enjoy dinner, then rest up for a splendid day of touring tomorrow. (dinner)

DAY 2: Enjoy the continental breakfast at the hotel, before heading out with our guide to tour historic Boston, from the brownstones of the Back Bay to the elegance of Beacon Hill. View the gold-domed State House, as well as the charming Old State House, site of dramatic events in the American Revolution. See Boston Common, the Public Garden, Old North Church,



where two lanterns signaled Paul Revere, and the historic warship *USS Constitution*. At colorful Faneuil Hall and Quincy Market, a vibrant part of Boston commerce for 250 years, you can walk the cobblestones, explore the shops, taste diverse ethnic foods, and enjoy roaming performers. Crossing the Charles River to Cambridge, tour Harvard Yard and learn about student life at the great university. Before returning to the hotel after the day's fun in Beantown, stop for a photo opportunity outside the bar that inspired the "Cheers" TV series. Dinner is included this evening. (breakfast, dinner)



DAY 3: After enjoying the continental breakfast at the hotel, return to Cambridge with a guide for an inspirational look at the life of President Kennedy at the JFK Library Museum. Next visit Boston's famous Prudential Center to explore its shops and restaurants. In the afternoon, journey to Concord and Lexington to relive the start of the American Revolution. See a Minuteman Statue, the Paul Revere Capture Site, Battle Road, and North Bridge, where "the shot heard round the world" was fired. You'll be ready to fight the redcoats before the day is done! Dinner is included this evening. (breakfast, dinner)

DAY 4: Enjoy the continental breakfast, then travel home from New England after historic fun in Boston. Expected arrival in Lancaster is 5:15 PM, York 6:00 PM, Red Lion 6:30 PM. (breakfast)
