(This team is thought to have found remnants of Cleopatra's royal palace as well as a pair of ancient cities lost under the sea.) The exhibit weaves such artifacts from the age of Cleopatra into the search for her complete history in a dramatic setting with high-definition multimedia presentations. Take a break from your archaeological adventure with lunch on your own in the museum's food court. You also have access to the other marvelous exhibits at the Franklin Institute. After experiencing the search for Cleopatra, enjoy another

Egyptian-themed experience, this time a stunning film presentation in the Institute's Tuttleman IMAX Theater entitled "Mummies: Secrets of the Pharaohs." Return after an intriguing day in Ancient Egypt, with expected arrival in Lancaster at 5:00 PM, York 5:45 PM, Red Lion 6:15 PM.
