Travel to Tilghman Island on Maryland's beautiful Eastern Shore to watch crab pickers, visit a seafood market, and learn about the local environment. Board the *Express Royale* to cruise on the Chesapeake, then delight in lunch at Harrison's Chesapeake House. See how jimmies and sooks are sorted and soft crabs cultivated, then relax in scenic St. Michaels. You'll feel crabby if you miss this beautiful day by the Bay!

Cross the Chesapeake Bay Bridge to arrive on Maryland's lovely Eastern Shore. Head toward Tilghman Island, "The Pearl of the Chesapeake," stopping at Bay Hundred Seafood for a crabmeat picking demonstration. Next visit a local seafood market, where you can buy crabmeat and other seafood packed for travel. Next visit Phillips



Wharf Environmental Center to learn about the plants, animals, and watermen of the Chesapeake. Then board the *Express Royale* for a delightful one-hour Chesapeake cruise, with narration about local history and ecology. Back on Tilghman Island, enjoy a delicious lunch at Harrison's Chesapeake House, where guests have relaxed by the bay for more than a century. In the afternoon, visit a crab wholesaler to see how sooks and jimmies are sorted and graded. At a soft crab shredding

operation, see how delicacies appear when crabs come out of their shells. Finally, enjoy free time in historic St. Michaels, home of colorful shops, galleries, and the Chesapeake Bay Maritime Museum. Return home after a splendid day by the bay, with expected arrival in Hunt Valley at 8:20 PM, Shrewsbury 8:40 PM, York 9:00 PM, Red Lion 9:30 PM.
