BRISTOL IRWIN TOOLS NIGHT RACE

August 20-22, 2010

Experience the great race known as the “toughest ticket in NASCAR!” Spend the night before and after the race, which was formerly known as the Bristol Sharpie 500, in a landmark hotel in Roanoke, Virginia. Arrive at the Bristol Speedway Saturday afternoon, ready for a thrilling race “under the lights.” From your great seat in the Junior Johnson Terrace, feel the thunder of a premier Sprint Cup event. After the race, rest in our classic hotel, leaving for home late next morning. It’s the civilized way to celebrate motorsports mania!

DAY 1: Arrive in Roanoke, VA, around 4:30 PM and check into The Hotel Roanoke & Conference Center (540-985-5900), a Doubletree Hotel nestled in the Blue Ridge Mountains. Listed in the National Registry of Historic Places, this classic hotel has been delighting travelers since 1888. Modernized at the cost of millions, the hotel boasts marble floors, vaulted ceilings, and the famous Regency circular dining room, considered a landmark of southwestern Virginia. (For more casual dining, try the Pine Room Pub.) An outdoor pool, exercise room and whirlpool add to the hotel’s amenities.



DAY 2: Enjoy breakfast in the hotel’s elegant Regency Room before departing late in the morning for the Bristol Motor Speedway in Tennessee. (The town of Bristol is in both Virginia and Tennessee; the border runs right through the town.) Enjoy the pre-race spectacle at the Speedway, and get ready for the rush of adrenaline this evening as many of the world’s best drivers race for glory in this great Sprint Cup event, now under the sponsorship of Irwin Tools.

From your seat in the Junior Johnson Terrace, vibrate to the roar of mighty engines and witness the blurring acceleration of the cars as drivers race around the high banks of “The World’s Fastest Half-Mile.” After the race concludes, relax and readjust to normal speed as we travel back to the Hotel Roanoke. (breakfast)



DAY 3: This morning, wake early to enjoy a classic hotel, or sleep in to recover from last night’s excitement. After breakfast in the Regency Room, depart for home late in the morning, with expected arrival in Hunt Valley at 5:20 PM, Shrewsbury 5:40 PM, York at 6:00 PM, Red Lion 6:30 PM. (breakfast)

NOTE: Shuttles will be used to pick up passengers at Capital City Airport and Grandview Plaza and transport them to Queensgate, where they will meet the Motorcoach. This is a family-oriented tour, and rowdiness will not be tolerated. Alcoholic beverages and smoking are not permitted on the bus. These rules are strictly enforced. In the event of postponement or cancellation of the race, ticket refunds are made only if available to Red Lion Tours. There will be no refund for transportation and other tour components after the motorcoach leaves the departure locations. In the event of rain, the bus will remain at the race until it is completed or cancelled by NASCAR officials.

PACKAGE INCLUDES: Deluxe Motorcoach transportation, 2 nights accommodations at the Hotel Roanoke, 2 breakfasts, reserved seating in the Junior Johnson Terrace (Section F, Rows 16-20) for the Bristol Irwin Tools Night Race 500 at the Bristol Motor Speedway, baggage handling, and escort.

Historic Hotel Roanoke

These were among PROHIBITED ITEMS inside the gates at Bristol Speedway in 2009

Folding stadium seats and folding chairs (but stadium cushion seats are permitted), umbrellas, more than one cooler (cooler cannot exceed 14 inches), more than one carry-in bag (bag cannot exceed 14 inches), glass containers, weapons of any kind, beer balls, fires, grills, fireworks, noise makers, horns, helium balloons, beach balls, and other items that may pose a safety hazard or diminish the enjoyment of an event by other patrons.
