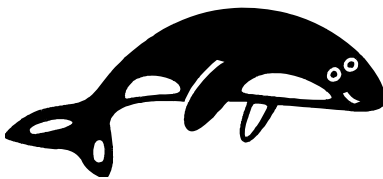
**DAY 1:** Begin this delightful summer adventure by traveling to Portland, Maine's city-by-the-sea, where we spend the night downtown in the historic Eastland Park Hotel (207-775-5411). Enjoy dinner in the hotel, check out the panoramic view from the rooftop lounge, and prepare for tomorrow's wildlife watching along the splendid seacoast. (dinner)



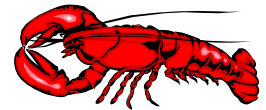
**DAY 2:** After breakfast, head to scenic Boothbay Harbor to embark on a Seal Watch Harbor Cruise. Cruise by a beautiful lighthouse, listen for the cry of gulls, and watch harbor seals sun themselves. Explore the resort village of Boothbay Harbor, where you can enjoy lunch on your own, then motor to Bar Harbor, the famed vacation retreat, where we will make our home for two nights at the Atlantic Eyre Lodge (207-288-9786) high on a bluff overlooking Frenchman Bay. A seafood choice dinner is included this evening. (breakfast, dinner)



**DAY 3:** Following breakfast, set out on a Whale Watch Cruise with a naturalist on board. Search for several species of the gentle giants, including finbacks, minkes, pilot whales, and humpback whales. Back in Bar Harbor, enjoy free time for browsing colorful boutiques and enjoying lunch on your own before heading to beautiful Acadia National Park in the afternoon. Travel Park Loop Road with a Park Ranger, look for bald eagles from atop Cadillac Mountain, see pristine lakes where beavers build their dams, and watch the surf crash at Thunder Hole. Explore wildlife exhibits at the Natural History Museum



on the campus of the College of the Atlantic, which is housed in a stone mansion facing Frenchman's Bay. This evening, don a souvenir lobster hat to observe your traditional Maine Lobsterbake being made. If you don't care to feast on lobster, you can choose halibut or steak as your entrée. (breakfast, dinner)

**DAY 4:** After breakfast, enter the Bar Harbor Oceanarium to check out crustaceans. Enjoy an entertaining presentation on lobstering and tour the Maine Lobster Hatchery. Motoring to Freeport, shop at the flagship store of famous L.L. Bean and at a myriad of outlets. Then meet many state natives at the Maine Wildlife Park, including deer, beaver, and, of course, mighty moose. Heading south, stop for the night at the Anchorage Inn (603-431-8111) in Portsmouth, NH, enjoying dinner nearby with your choice of seafood entrees. (breakfast, dinner)



**DAY 5:** After a continental breakfast, head home with marvelous memories of wildlife and beauty along the rocky coast of Maine. Expected arrival in Lancaster is 6:15 PM, York, 7:00 PM, Red Lion 7:30 PM. (breakfast)

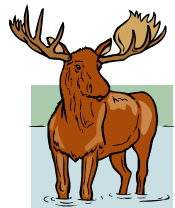

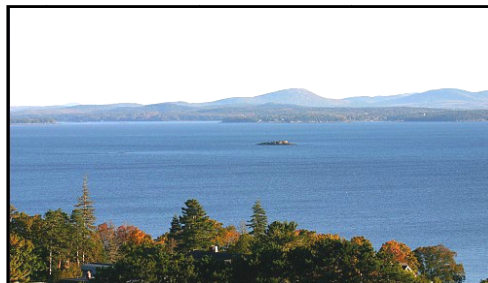
**DEPOSIT:** A deposit of **\$275** is due within **10 days** of booking. Seat assignments are made based upon when we receive payment for your booked tour.
