

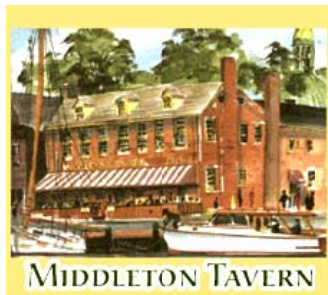


ANNAPOLIS, MARYLAND & US NAVAL ACADEMY

September 1, 2010

Come with us to Annapolis, the “sailing capital of the world.” Begin with a tour of the storied US Naval Academy, where midshipmen are trained for command in the Navy and Marines. Relax over lunch at historic Middleton Tavern. Stroll and shop in quaint streets downtown, then board the *Harbor Queen* for a narrated cruise of the harbor and along the Naval Academy. It’s a beautiful day by the bay in historic Annapolis!

Head to Annapolis, the “sailing capital of the world,” to begin a guided tour of the US Naval Academy at 10:00 AM. Starting at the USNA Visitor’s Center and ending at the Annapolis City Dock, our extensive 1 ½ hour walking tour introduces you to the storied Academy, where midshipmen have been trained “morally, mentally, and physically” since 1845. Enjoy lunch at Middleton Tavern near the dock,



an historic establishment that has served both George Washington and Ben Franklin. (Second floor seating requires walking up stairs.) You’ll have a little free time for strolling and shopping in the quaint downtown before boarding the *Harbor Queen* for a 40-minute narrated cruise in Annapolis Harbor and along the Naval Academy. Glimpse bridges spanning the Chesapeake, and enjoy lovely views of Annapolis as sailors see it. Return home after the cruise, delighted by a fascinating day in Maryland’s charming capital. Expected arrival in Hunt Valley is 4:50 PM, Shrewsbury 5:10 PM, York is 5:30 PM, Red Lion 6:00 PM.

There is a fee of **\$40** per person for cancellations received after this date. Plus any money for tour features or services paid to suppliers for your reservation, that is not refunded to Red Lion, can not be refunded to you. This includes any expenses we incur as a result of the cancellation. **NO REFUND** for cancellations received within **48 hours** of tour departure. All cancellation calls must be received during regular office hours, no voice mail messages.

NO REFUNDS for failure to show up on day of tour. **SORRY– NO EXCEPTIONS!** Any refunds will be paid after tour has completed and refunds have been received from suppliers by Red Lion.

CANCELLATION/INTERRUPTION INSURANCE: We recommend you purchase insurance so if you have to cancel your reservation due to illness or a death in the family, you will be able to file an insurance claim to get your money refunded. If purchased within 7 days of your initial payment, pre-existing medical conditions will be waived. The cost is **\$19** per person.
