

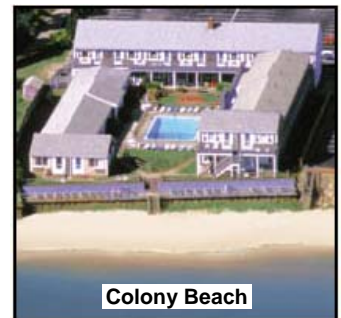


NEWPORT, MYSTIC & MORE

September 5-8, 2010

Stay at the beachfront Colony Inn on Cape Cod during this terrific tour. Have lunch aboard an historic battleship in Fall River. Heading to Newport, Rhode Island, cruise in the sparkling bay and harbor, visit two mansions along the scenic ocean drive, and shop at bustling Brick Market. On the way home, enjoy hours at Connecticut's marvelous Mystic Seaport. It's a great escape to fun and beauty in New England!

DAY 1: Traveling north to New England's scenic Cape Cod, check into Colony Beach in Dennisport, MA (508-398-2217), our home for the next three nights. Enjoy a welcome reception at the hotel, which overlooks picturesque Nantucket Sound and features a private beach. After dinner at a fine local restaurant, relax and rest up for a delightful day tomorrow. (dinner)

DAY 2: After enjoying breakfast, depart with our guide for Battleship Cove in Fall River, MA, where you can explore the world's largest collection of historic naval ships in a spectacular waterfront setting.

Boarding the Battleship USS *Massachusetts* (affectionately called the "Big Mamie" by its crew), we will enjoy a lunch buffet on this storied combat ship, which fired both the first 16" projectile during WW II (off Casablanca) and the last (off Japan). Next motor to scenic Newport, Rhode Island, to enjoy a cruise on the sparkling waters of Newport Harbor and Naragansett Bay. After this delightful day on the waterfront, return to our hotel to relax before our dinner with entertainment this evening. (breakfast, lunch, dinner)

DAY 3: After enjoying breakfast, we'll head back to Newport to take a scenic ocean drive past splendid "cottages," which are actually vast mansions built as summer retreats by Gilded Age tycoons. Stop to tour one of these amazing homes. For lunch on your own, we head to Newport's Brick Market, where restaurants and specialty shops occupy four acres of the seaport. Visit another beautiful mansion this afternoon before returning to our hotel on the Cape. This evening, enjoy a delicious lobster dinner. (breakfast, dinner)

DAY 4: After a last breakfast on the Cape, head toward home, anticipating a great treat en route in the form of admission to Connecticut's colorful Mystic Seaport. Enjoy a few hours of free time to stroll through this re-created 19th century Seafaring Village. Check out a working preservation shipyard, and board Tall Ships berthed in port. You'll swear you've returned to the days when Mystic built clipper ships! Arrive home this evening refreshed by your beautiful New England escape, with expected arrival in Lancaster at 8:45 PM, York 9:30 PM, Red Lion 10:00 PM. (breakfast)

FINAL PAYMENT: Balance due by **July 22, 2010**.

CANCELLATIONS: Cancellation date is **July 22, 2010**. Full refund will be given if cancelled by this date except for some tours such as Broadway Shows and Nascar, etc. These may involve non-refundable payments. There is a fee of **\$75** per person for cancellations received after this date. Plus any money for tour features or services paid to suppliers for your reservation, that is not refunded to Red Lion, can not be refunded to you. This includes any expenses we incur as a result of the cancellation. **NO REFUND** for cancellations received within **48 hours** of tour departure. All cancellation calls must be received during regular office hours, no voice mail messages. **NO REFUNDS** for failure to show up on day of tour. **SORRY – NO EXCEPTIONS!** Any refunds will be paid after tour has completed and refunds have been received from suppliers by Red Lion.

CANCELLATION/INTERRUPTION INSURANCE: We recommend you purchase insurance so if you have to cancel your reservation due to illness or a death in the family, you will be able to file an insurance claim to get your money refunded. If purchased within 7 days of your initial payment, pre-existing medical conditions will be waived. The cost is **\$64** per person based on double occupancy.
