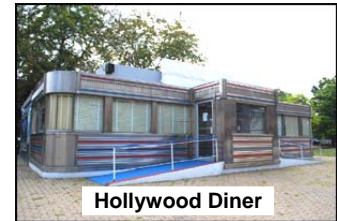

(You may remember scenes from "The Diner" that helped make stars of the young Mickey Rourke, Steve Guttenberg, Tim Daly, Paul Reiser, and Kevin Bacon.) Head home around 3:00 PM after a fun day viewing Charm City as it's seen in the world of film and television.
