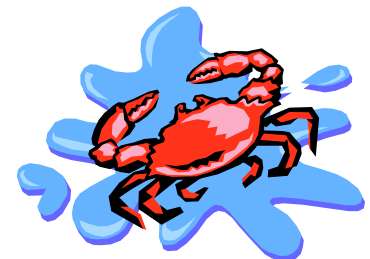
Enjoy a lovely Saturday in St. Michaels on Maryland's scenic Eastern Shore. Start with lunch at the famous *Crab Claw* restaurant on the town dock. Stroll historic streets among lovingly restored homes, enchanting inns, and interesting boutiques. For a fascinating look at local history, pay admission to explore the Chesapeake Bay Maritime Museum. Finish on a high note, cruising the Miles River aboard the *Patriot*. For a touch of serenity, come with us to pretty St. Michaels!

Head to Maryland's Eastern Shore to visit picturesque St. Michaels, which combines colonial history and Victorian charm. The town is a haven from hurly-burly and the perfect place to discover the beauty and bounty of the Bay. Start your visit in fine fashion with lunch at the famous Crab Claw restaurant, noted equally for its Maryland Blue Crabs and its spectacular view of the harbor. (Order your lunch ahead, selecting as your entrée two crab cakes or crab imperial, or, if you're not feeling crabby, Delmarva fried chicken.)



After the satisfying lunch, take time to enjoy the delights of St. Michaels. Stroll along charming Talbot Street and browse its colorful shops, galleries, and antique stores. Wander among historic sites, enchanting inns, and lovingly restored homes. You may wish to explore the Chesapeake Bay Maritime Museum, where the story of the Bay and its people is brought to life in many exhibits, an 1879 lighthouse, and a working boat yard. (There is an admission fee for the museum.)

Later in the afternoon, head to the dock to board the M/V *Patriot* for a delightful cruise up the Miles River, an arm of the Chesapeake. Enjoy a narrated history of Talbot County, view historic homes and waterfowl, and look for the watermen who harvest the bounty of the bay area. Back on shore, board our motorcoach to return home after an intriguing day in scenic St. Michaels, with expected arrival in Hunt Valley 7:20 PM, Shrewsbury 7:40 PM, York 8:00 PM, Red Lion 8:30 PM.
