EAT YOUR WAY THROUGH BEDFORD

September 26, 2010

Pretty countryside, historic sights, covered bridges, and food aplenty are the ingredients of this tasty tour to Bedford town and county. Savor food at several stops, with the main course at Slick's Ivy Stone Restaurant, where you will be served by waitresses in colonial garb. This very popular tour pleases eye and belly!

Enjoy a scenic ride to Pennsylvania's Southern Alleghenies at the start of autumn. On the way into the town of Bedford, see picturesque Claycomb Covered Bridge, then wake up with coffee and pastry at Founder's Crossing, an antiques shop. Discover highlights of the town, including fabulous Bedford Springs Hotel, the state's oldest operational court house, a pre-Revolutionary War cemetery, and a Civil War monument. Journeying on Old Forbes Trail, arrive at Jean Bonnet Tavern. Enjoy soup, salad, rolls, and lemonade – and get scared by tales of bodies in the basement. Nearby, visit historic Schellsburg Log Church with its interesting interior and old cemetery, then motor to pretty-as-a-picture Snook Covered Bridge. Thousands of trout swim nearby at Reynoldsdale Fish Culture Station, a fascinating stop for fishermen. All this touring makes a body hungry, so we visit Slick's Ivy Stone Restaurant for our main course, served by waitresses in colonial garb. Next visit Bowser Covered Bridge before reaching Ridgetop Orchards, where you can observe a big apple packing operation and buy fresh apples. For a sweet finish, head to Old Bedford Village to enjoy an 18th century colonial dessert in the Pendergrass Tavern.
