Traveling to Maryland's scenic Eastern Shore, board a boat on Tilghman Island to cruise the Chesapeake. Learn all about oystering, and visit an oyster shucking operation. Enjoy lunch at Harrison's Chesapeake House, a traditional favorite, and enjoy free time in charming St. Michaels. It's a beautiful day on the Bay!

Cross the Chesapeake Bay Bridge to arrive this morning on Maryland's beautiful Eastern Shore. Motor down a pretty peninsula near St. Michaels and cross a drawbridge to discover Tilghman Island, "The Pearl of the Chesapeake." Return home after a splendid day by the bay, with expected arrival in Hunt Valley at 8:20 PM, Shrewsbury 8:40 PM, York 9:00 PM, Red Lion 9:30 PM.
