



## HISTORIC BALTIMORE HOUSES

October 21, 2010

**For a delightful day in Baltimore, tour two elegant and historic mansions, Evergreen and Homewood, view other famous city homes on our motorcoach tour, and delight in the colorful Cafe Hon! It's memorable fun!**

Arriving on the north side of Baltimore, head first to Evergreen House, a Gilded Age mansion surrounded by Italian-style gardens that was home to generations of the

Garrett family, whose wealth was based on a railroad empire. Here we meet our local guide, then proceed to a docent-led tour of the mansion, whose 48 opulent rooms, including an ornate library, are filled with the priceless fine and decorative arts and rare books collected by the Garretts. After touring Evergreen, enjoy a narrated motorcoach tour of Baltimore highlighting other famous homes, such as the Robert Long House, Edgar Allan Poe House, Babe Ruth Birthplace, and Carroll Mansion. For lunch, have fun

at Cafe Hon, a Hamden neighborhood institution marked by a 30-foot pink flamingo and noted for retro décor, saucy waitresses, "Bawlmerese" slang, and good food. Then tour a neo-classical gem, Homewood House on the Johns Hopkins Campus. This Federal-style landmark was presented as a wedding gift to his son from Charles Carroll of Carrollton, a signer of the Declaration of Independence, and the decorative arts and furnishings in the home are representative of the period when the Carroll family lived here (1775-1825). Enjoy a docent-led tour of the historic house before heading north, dropping off our guide at Evergreen, and returning home after a delightful day in "Bawlmer." Expected arrival in Hunt Valley at 3:50 PM, Shrewsbury 4:10 PM, York is 4:30 PM, Red Lion 5:00 PM.
