



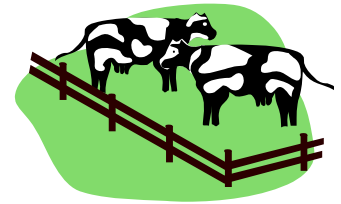
## NORTHEAST TENNESSEE ADVENTURE

October 24-27, 2010

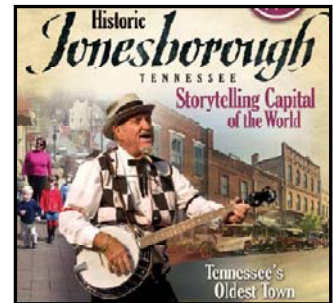
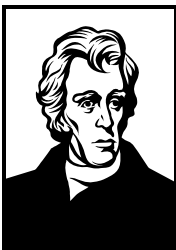
Escape to beautiful places and old-time fun! Stay in Kingsport, explore lovely Bays Mountain Park by barge, look for abundant wildlife, and hear howling wolves. Experience 19<sup>th</sup> century farm life at Exchange Place, see a fossil site where camels and elephants cavorted, and visit Jonesborough, the storytelling center where Andy Jackson presided as judge. This terrific tour is a Tennessee treat!

**DAY 1:** For an unforgettable escape to a beautiful place, head to Kingsport in the northeast corner of Tennessee, where we will stay three nights at the Hampton Inn (423-247-3888). Enjoy dinner this evening at the Sagebrush Steakhouse. (dinner)

**DAY 2:** Enjoy a hot continental breakfast at the hotel before entering serene Bays Mountain Park, a nature preserve framed by mountain ridges and inhabited by abundant wildlife, including deer, raccoon, ducks, geese, turtles, great blue heron, bobcat, and black bear. Delight in a barge ride on a secluded lake, with a park ranger aboard to lead us to a place where trained wolves howl in greeting. At Bays Mountain Farmstead Museum, learn how life was lived on a 19<sup>th</sup> century farm and enjoy lunch. After spending a little time in Kingsport, take a memorably fun drive that brings us to Exchange Place, a living history museum that recaptures life in the early 1800s. Tour the property, which was once a self-contained plantation, a relay station on the Old Stage Road, and a post office. You will see typical old farmstead buildings and a working farm with historic breeds, and you may sense the presence of Daniel Boone, who "killd a bar" here in 1775, carving a record of his deed in a tree. Enjoy dinner at Exchange Place, with entertainment and storytelling. (breakfast, lunch, dinner)



**DAY 3:** After the continental breakfast at the hotel, discover the Gray Fossil Site being explored by East Tennessee State University. Attracting scholars from around the country, the site provides evidence that alligators, red pandas, camels, sloth, elephants, rhinos, tapirs, saber-toothed cats, and species totally new to science all cavorted here in bygone ages. Head next to Jonesborough for a guided tour of the oldest town in Tennessee, where future President Andy Jackson was a judge. Enjoy lunch on Main Street at Old Quarters, do a little shopping, then visit the fascinating Storytelling Center. A Jonesborough mayor kicked off an international renaissance in storytelling back in 1973, and you will learn about the storytelling movement and meet a teller in residence at this unique center. Riverfront Seafood welcomes us for dinner this evening. (breakfast, lunch, dinner)



**DAY 4:** Enjoy the continental breakfast at the hotel, then return home from this terrific Tennessee tour, treasuring your special time in a simpler world, with expected arrival in Hunt Valley at 5:50 PM, Shrewsbury 6:10 PM, York 6:30 PM, Red Lion 7:00 PM. (breakfast)

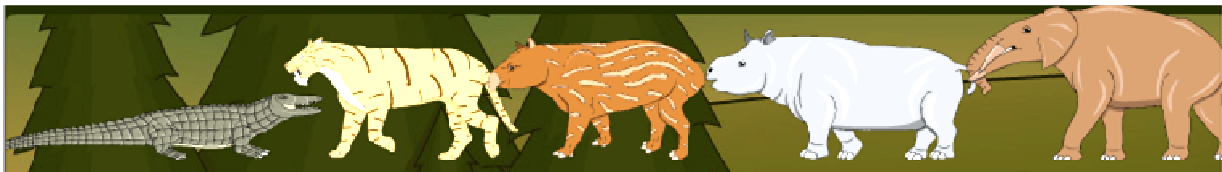
