Head to charming Wellsboro, PA, for the annual Dickens of a Christmas festival, a celebration of Victorian Christmas traditions. Stroll Main Street and surrounding areas to browse crafts sold by costumed vendors. Savor "Dickens treats" like hot cider, gingerbread cookies, or handmade chocolates. Let roving entertainers, dancers, and bands brighten your spirits, and enjoy the bountiful buffet at Country Cupboard on the way home. You will return in a merry mood from pretty Wellsboro, where they know how to keep Christmas well!

Arrive around 11:30 AM in pretty little Wellsboro in northern Pennsylvania for the annual Dickens of a Christmas festival. Step back into the Victorian Age as you stroll Main Street and surrounding areas, which are closed to traffic. Townsfolk dressed in period costumes will welcome you and thousands of other visitors to this special holiday celebration. The festival varies from year to year, but usually costumed vendors offer handcrafted wooden items, ceramics, clay pottery, Christmas ornaments, wrought iron, jewelry, heirloom Santas, and more. Be tempted by tasty Dickens treats, such as hot cider, apple dumplings, hot soups, homemade cookies, kettle corn, fresh roasted peanuts, crab cakes, and more. Roving "Dickens Players" provide entertainment, with local choirs, bands, and dancers joining in the fun. Horse-drawn wagon rides on Main Street have been part of this colorful event, and churches, a theater, and an art center offer tours, services, indoor craft shows, concerts or performances. After a day of festive fun, depart Wellsboro at 4:00 PM, stopping at the Country Cupboard in Lewisburg for a bountiful buffet dinner (including carved prime rib



and ham, broasted chicken, and more) and time for a little browsing in the shops. Return home from this unique celebration in a merry mood, with expected arrival in New Cumberland at 8:50 PM, York 9:30 PM, Red Lion 10:00 PM.
