## SIGHTS & SOUNDS OF CHRISTMAS

December 9, 2010

For a day of Christmas delights, come with us to the Hagerstown, Maryland area. Hear a Christmas choir in historic St. Mark's Episcopal Church. Shop for bargains among 100 stores at Prime Outlets. Learn how German immigrants celebrated Christmas in the 1700s at the Hager House. Watch model trains rush through an elaborate snow scene at the Hagerstown Roundhouse Museum. It's holiday fun sure to brighten your Christmas spirits!



Traveling to scenic Western Maryland, stop first at Lappan's Cross Roads south of Hagerstown to enter St. Marks Episcopal Church, founded more than 150 years ago. Tour the historic church, hear the sounds of Christmas presented by the church choir, and enjoy Christmas cookies and tea. Traveling to Hagerstown, stop at Prime Outlets, home of 100 brand-name outlet stores that offer savings of up to 65%. Shop for bargains and have lunch on your own. Next enter the Hager House to see the stout home built by the founder of Hagerstown in 1740. (Constructed of uncut fieldstone above a spring, the home served as a fort that could resist Indian attack.)



Learn how Hager and other early immigrants celebrated Christmas in German style. Finally, visit the Hagerstown Roundhouse Museum, which explores the



local railroading heritage that gave Hagerstown the nickname of "Hub City." Enjoy the "The Visions, Sounds and Snows of Christmas Past & Present," a Christmas train show featuring an "O" Scale 3-rail Christmas layout with steam and diesel trains by Lionel, MTH, Williams, Weaver, and others running through a four-level snow scene. Other O and HO trains will also be in operation, and you can check out railroad artifacts, photos, trains for kids to run, and a gift shop. Return home after a day of Christmas delights, with expected arrival in New Cumberland at 7:20 PM, York 8:00 PM, Red Lion 8:30 PM.
